An Overview and Remarkable Achievements of IDEAL

IDEAL (Institute of Development Education for Advancement of Landless) is a local NGO established in 1987 in Parulia village of Debhata Upazila under Satkhira District of Bangladesh. IDEAL took registration from department Social welfare in 1991, NGO- AB in 1996 Department of Youth development in 2003 and Microcredit regulatory authority in 2008. IDEAL have a Constitution and the the organization is directed by the constitution.

Initially (1987) IDEAL started to organize local poor people into different homogenous groups with the objective to secure their rights and to help them assume responsibilities which would be leaded to their empowerment and promote self-employment through own funded micro financing & saving, Services for disabled people, economic development of poor families, development of the environment. In 1998 IDEAL turned its activities into rights based approach and involved with land rights movement for the landless, formed the people's organizations especially with women for ensuring their rights and Agricultural Technology transfer programs are started for agriculture development and employment generation. In 2000, IDEAL lunched huge relief and rehabilitation programs for the flood victim's people in southwestern part of the country. After that IDEAL started child and women trafficking prevention programs. In 2003 IDEAL started Reducing Vulnerability to Climate Change (RVCC) programs with CARE Bangladesh as southwestern part of the country is frequently affected by climate change effects. Based on the experiences in 2005 IDEAL initiated another project namely Empowering Working Women in Shrimp farm funded by Manusher Janno, a rights-based program for working women's in shrimp farms. IDEAL is experienced on implementation of diversified programing like livelihood both on farm & off farm, health and sanitation, Disaster response, Child right protection (Combat to human trafficking), response to disability, youth development especially with Life skills and skill development, non-formal primary education and adult educations with the assistant of different partner like CARE Bangladesh, BNF, MJF, Shiree- Uttaran, MOWCA etc. Biogas Plant installation and development is very recent experience of IDEAL.

IDEAL have a constitution to manage it by a general body consist of 21members of enthusiastic, dynamic and experienced social volunteer from the locality member who are the sole authority to make any changes of the constitution and a 7 members of executive committee who is responsible for functional the IDEAL activities and provide all kind of approval as per the direction of general body. Generally the executive body hold their meeting at least quarterly or as per requirement when arises. The general body meeting hold once in a year where they approved if any policy related changes is required.

Programs

A. Organization Building and Micro-credit Program

From its inception IDEAL has been organizing the local poor people into different homogenous primary groups. Actually these groups are the grassroots level development association for the poor people. These groups are the primary forum for taking any development decision, planning and problem solving. This forum is assisting them to be empowered for their solidarity and helps to ensure their rights. IDEAL facilitated them for formation of bigger forum accordingly they formed Union federation with all groups of each union and Upazila level federation with all union federation. In each primary group there is a weekly meeting where they trained in different issues like land rights, Health and sanitation, importance of savings, Proper utilization of credit money, value based education, child education, Alternative Livelihood option, protection of Child right especially Child marriage, Child trafficking, schooling etc. The Groups leader is meeting once in month at union federation level where they conduct their monthly meeting accordingly Upazila level federation meeting held. In the meeting mainly take decisions regarding to establishment of their right success Problem and way of solutions.

A total of 965 primary groups organized (44 male and 921 female) covering 17636 members in to those groups. With these groups 46 union federations & 8 upazila federations have been formed. IDEAL also encourages the Groups Members (GM) for weekly saving. An amount of TK 9,98,35,069 has been saved which covering per member tk 5660. IDEAL Micro financing programming is different than others NGO's micro financing programing. IDEAL is operating this programming by their own fund not from any assistance of any donors. This fund is used for to create the alternative livelihood options to the group member. Beside this operating housing loan program with assistance of Bangladesh Bank fund Since inception IDEAL provided micro finance to the 10250 families in addition provide house loan to 38 families. Rights and Good Governance Program



Empowerment of Agricultural Workers in SatkhiraBangladesh is a country of 170 million people, most of them are rural based and live on agriculture. Approximately half of the agricultural lands in rural areas are owned by only 10% of the people who cultivate their own lands and known as "farmer" but three quarters of the rural population are landless, who are "agricultural labourers/workers". These "agricultural workers" constitute a huge labour force comparing to our other labour sectors, about 52 percent of the total labour force is engaged in agriculture sector. Only the agriculture sector contributes 35 percent of the total GDP of Bangladesh economy.

As regard social acceptance of the agricultural workers, they have limited scope to participation in the social activities, most importantly access to the government and non-government facilities are very limited. IDEAL (Institute of Development Education for Advancement of Landless) has been working in Satkhira district as a proven NGO for the community empowerment focusing on agricultural workers since its inception. IDEAL has helped the community people organizing different groups to create demand and achieve their rights. It has experienced to assist the Shrimp (Gher) workers to raise their voice for claiming their rights and also to find dignified livelihood, addressing the violation against women and other challenges they face in their workplace. IDEAL has been working for ensuring workers' rights to improve working environment of the workers in agricultural sectors in the working area. IDEAL has been also working for raising awareness to the primary and secondary stakeholders on basic human and labour rights to enforce rights in the work place; develop capacity and skills on alternative livelihood; build-up strong network different organizations for policy advocacy and lobby.


Bio Gas Project.

Renewable Energy Program

Bio gas Program

Biogas is predominantly a mixture of methane and carbon dioxide. It is a Renewable Energy Program. Biogas plants not only provide gas for cooking purpose but also produce organic fertilizer for the crops and fish pond. The program helps reduce the use of biomass fuel for cooking. Till June 2017, By the support of IDCOL IDEAL has financed construction of over 560 biogas plants in Satkhira and Khulna district. In this financial (2021-2022) year Till June 2022 IDEAL distributed loan Tk.84, 18,995/- among biogas plant beneficiaries and overall recovery 90%.

The implementation of biogas program Fuel savings, less time cooking, Production of organic manure, Freedom from diseases caused by smoke the biogas users more benefits. Over and above customers can build biogas plants through easy installments. IDCOL giving subsidy for establishing biogas plant. But people can't come out from traditional system and it is a big challenge.





Improved cook stove (ICS) Program:

Improved cook stove (ICS) is a device that is designed to improve fire effectiveness of biomass, consume less fuel, save cooking time, convenient in cooking process and creates smokeless environment in the kitchen or reduction in the volume of smoke produced during cooking against the traditional stove. IDEAL is also implementing improved cook stove (ICS) program by the support of IDCOL. Till June 2022 IDEAL established 19030 improved cook stove (ICS) in Kalaroa upazilla under Satkhira district.







VGD Program

The ultimate goal of the programme is to bring sustainable improvement by ensuring the Vulnerable women's food security to the lives of ultra-poor households. The development package includes life skills and income generating skills training as well as a personal savings programme. IDEAL Providing life skill and skill trainings for the vulnerable women and collecting saving from the beneficiaries that they are able to fight against the poverty.





Gender and Development

Gender sensitivity is one of the important strategies of IDEAL, because IDEAL believes that no actual development is possible without equal participation of women at all level. IDEAL has a gender policy. So, IDEAL introduced gender responsiveness in all its activities. Gender advocacy is continuous process of the organization through training, workshop, seminar, day observation and publication. Gender issue is not a different program rather it is involved with other programs of the organization. IDEAL tries to ensure participation of women in all programs of the organization.

Housing Program

IDEAL have been implementing house program with financial assistance of Bangladesh bank. It is really fact that due to lack of low financial capability the low income peoples especially the rural poor's and hard core poor's people live in the muddy house made by the clay wall and using the straw or piece of Gole pata leaf for shading purpose. Which is need every year repair. Some time it was broken by storm which is common phenomena of the southern Bangladesh area. So it need every year repairing, the poor people need to carry an extra expenditure in every year. Satkhira district is more vulnerable for this situation. Considering the issue IDEAL is working with Bangladesh Bank to provide financial and technical support with low interest to prepare the low cost but sustainable housing.IDEAl is implementing the this project from 2010 nd responsinle for covering area of 4 sub-district of Satkhira district (Satkhira sadar, Assasuni, kaligonj & Debhata) and initially targeted for 106 Families.

Environmental Protection and Respond to Climate Change Program

Integration of Gender into Climate Change Adaptation and Low Carbon Development Project

Climate change is the one of the most threatened issue all over the world. Bangladesh is the most vulnerable country for climate change and southern coastal area of the country is the most susceptible area for climate change. Salinity and shrimp farming has been added with the climate change threats and degraded the environment of the southwestern coastal area.

Environmental degradation is a severe problem in southern Bangladesh. Most of the rivers have been silted up due to unplanned cross dam. As result of river siltation, water logging becomes a very critical issue in this region. Most of the agricultural lands are under shrimp culture. Shrimp business and subsequent shrimp farms are under the control of rich people. It is a capital intensive business and required less numbers of laborers. On the other hand marginal farmers are forced to lease their lands to big shrimp farm owners. So a wide number of people who are landless, day laborers, marginal farmers and sharecroppers have been workless and lost their access to lands and resources. The effect and causes of climate change is unknown to the target people and like-minded neighbors. No body has come forward to aware regarding the issues and it is less priority to the villagers although it is their daily life and every moment they are struggling to cope with the changing phenomenon. They are use to think on fate rather beyond it. IDEAL has selected the proposed area based on that the area is severely affected by the climate change factors and the households have no awareness on climate change issues. They have no alternative way rather coping with the changing factors and always facing the problems. Their society and socio-economy is based on those factors. In fact the selected area life, habitats, earning source, social custom, relation within the society and thinking are centered and move with changing the climate. IDEAL is working in the southern region since its inception. As a local organization IDEAL has commitment to the people. As the main social and environmental problem which severely affecting the poor section society, IDEAL is addressing the issues. In this project IDEAL has been trying to involve the women in the development project.

Poverty alleviation and sustainable development of Hardcore Poor people through Sheep rearing

Environmental degradation is a severe problem in southern Bangladesh. Wide number of people who are landless, day laborers, marginal farmers and sharecroppers have been workless and lost their access to lands and resources. Poor are the most vulnerable to the effects of climatic change. IDEAL is carrying out different activities to manage environment in a sustainable manner and develop the hard-core poor. IDEAL has provided Goat rearing training to 30 beneficiaries of Parulia and Kulia union. IDEAL distributed Sheep to 30 families. Awareness development training-workshop was arranged for 30 male and female members. In the southern area total number of livestock is becoming less. Every year

significant number of livestock dies due to lack of proper treatment and different epidemics. In this situation IDEAL is trying to livestock development. IDEAL is providing vaccinator training and also proving vaccination kits box to the trained vaccinator. These activities have created very positive impact among the poor farmers of the Upazila. Other farmers are learning from the target farmers.

Now people are more aware about the environmental problem. They are now conscious about how they are being affected by environmental disorders. Poor beneficiaries' economic condition and dignity is increasing by rearing goat. They are conscious about any activities subversive to the environment and they are trying to introduce different types of income generating activities to cope with the changing situation. It is great achievement for the people.





Accelerating the Genetic In Rice: (AGGRi)-NARES, Bangladesh Project

IDEAL has been engaged in social development works since its inception in 1987. Through the continuation the organization is implementing from 2011 the project "Sustainable Rice Seed Production and Delivery System for Southern Bangladesh" by the support of International Rice Research Institution (IRRI) and funded by NARES. In the southern part of Bangladesh the organization arranged saline tolerant rice seed production procedure training, rice seed distribution and preservation within this project. IDEAL has provided more productive paddy seeds and financial benefits for the farmer's development in harmony with the environment supported by IRRI. This year, IDEAL provides high yielding 15 varieties of paddy seeds free of cost to no of 35 farmers in 4 upazilla. Apart from this, 36 farmers also supply paddy seeds through 4 dealers. 06 farmers also supply paddy seeds through 01 claster denostration. The detail reports of BORO-2021 are given below

Main objectives of the project are as follows:

- Systematic identification of superior product of delivering genetic gain in farmer field.
- Creating demand for new varieties among seed chain stakeholder.
- Creating and executing gender segregated dissemination plans for promising products.

• Increasing rate of varietal adaption and turnover.





Humanitarian Aid Program Development of Disabled People through Providing Integrated Support

IDEAL has been implementing Promoting Rights and Inclusion of the Disable people for their Empowerment financial and technical support of DRRA since 2016 as IDEAL learnt through implementation of project that there is essential needs of Health, Education, Livelihood, Social And Empowerment support for the children & youngster with disable as well as persons with disabilities for establishing their dignity and profound voice for making decision and empowerment as a whole. IDEAL has successfully implemented this project and designed result have been achieved some extent but after monitoring and internal evaluation it was found that further support is needed for the targeted children with disabilities, Youngsters and persons with disabilities. The implementation of this project has created people's confidence in the organization at the local level. The attitude of creating a friendly environment is created in the presence of the organization. The implementation of the project has seen positive change at the stakeholder level outside the organization which is as follows:

- 1. IDEAL has gained the confidence of the stakeholders.
- 2. Disabilities or stakeholders outside the project union come to receive services from the organization.
- 3. As a result of implementation of the project, the local administration has adopted IDEAL as a positive
- 4. The beneficiaries of the project are trusting the organization
- 5. Providing services to people with disabilities has increased the acceptance of the organization to the people of the area
- 6. IDEAL has a much higher acceptance among the companies that work with disabilities.
- 7 IDEAL are acceptance of primary schools and other service IDEAL works by maintaining good relations with the local administration.

As a result, the local administration provides any financial or any other kind of assistance to the organization. As a result positive effect on the project.

There is no challenge / obstacle at the community level in implementing the Pride project activities. As the project area is inaccessible, there are many challenges / barriers in communication





IDEAL is continuing different development activities for the betterment of the disabled children. IDEAL is trying to merge the disabled children with the main stream of the society. With all other program of the organization disability has one of the main issues. Disability issue gets priority at all level of the organization. IDEAL is getting very good response for different activities regarding disabled child development.

Human resource development is the ongoing and regular process of IDEAL. Main resources of IDEAL are its manpower, knowledge and team sprit. Training section of IDEAL regularly organizes different development training for the staff members. IDEAL purchases trainings from different capable organization at national level.

Gross Achievements of the Organization

- Getting asset and cash support from IDEAL in Kaligonj Upazila 1610 Hard Core Poor family come out from their extreme poverty.
- Wages for women labors has been increased from Tk. 80 to Tk.110
- Working condition in the agricultural sectors has been improved for women laborers.
- Women mobility has been increased and they have been more vocal than before.
- Union level women federations have been formed with a permanent office set up
- Debhata and Kaligong upazila of Satkhira district has been come under 100% sanitation coverage. Now IDEAL is working for sustainability of hygiene and sanitation
- IDEAL has accomplished 52 km road side plantation under its social forestry program with participation of hardcore poor people.
- 98% beneficiary of IDEAL has successfully used micro credit in their income generating projects and refund their loan

Major Challenges Faced

- Effects of Climate change (like water logging, river siltation, river erosion, embankment damage, cyclone, tidal surge, salinity etc.) are hampering the development initiatives of IDEAL
- Scattered population and poor communication facilities
- Shrimp farming replacing agricultural crops rapidly, limits local resources and results less income generation
- Increasing number of judgment (mediation, salish) makes often individual threat for the IDEAL staffs
- Extreme religious mentality often creates a barrier for women development
- Lack of cooperation for the LEBs, legal authorities (Police stations, staffs of lower courts) and local elites
